1 Introduction

In order to ensure that high quality proceedings will be published, authors are advised to prepare manuscripts following the guidelines detailed in this guide. The layout of this guide can be served as a sample. Should there be any doubt, please contact us via E-mail: icdes2020@jsde.or.jp.

2 Format of manuscripts

2.1 Paper size and pages

Authors should prepare their manuscripts in single column format for printing on A4 (210 mm × 297 mm) paper and must ensure that the completed manuscript is more than page two (2) and not exceeding ten (10) pages.

2.2 Margins

Authors must ensure that the typing area (centered) matches the guidelines given below:

- (a) The distance from the top edge of the paper should be 29 mm. Then, on the first page, to insert one empty line before the first line of type (i.e. the Title) should be almost 35 mm.
- (b) The bottom margin should be 28 mm. No page number should appear in the manuscript.
- (c) The left and right margins must be the same, namely 20.5 mm.

2.3 Lines per page

Set to forty-five (45) lines per page (The space between lines sets 15pt). Do not put a chapter/section heading at the bottom of a column.

3 Fonts

Try to use proportional Times Roman font only, justified if possible, in order to avoid printing troubles. Don't use

multibyte characters. Then, please follow the font sizes as listed in **Table 1**.

Figure captions with bold type	10 pt.

4 Headings (Style: Chapter Headings)

Chapter headings should be aligned left in the column in capital letters, bold font and numbered consecutively, starting with Introduction.

4.1 Sub-headings (Style: Section Headings)

Clause and section headings should be numbered 1.1, 1.2, 2.1.1, etc.

5 Figures and tables

Figures and tables must be numbered consecutively. The figure and table requires the blank lines above and below. Avoid placing figures and tables before their first mention in the text.

The figure number and caption should be typed below the illustration, centered, with subsequent lines indented. The resolution of the picture/figure with over 300DPI / 600DPI is highly recommended. The colored pictures/figures are allowed to use in your manuscript for electric publishing.

The table number and caption should be typed above the tables, centered, with subsequent lines indented.

Use to refer the figure and table in the text as, for examples, “**Figure 1** shows that...” or “The experimental results are represented in **Fig. 2** and **Table 1**.”

6 Equations, units and variables

The equations must be numbered consecutively, and are referred as, for example, “Equation (1) shows that ...” and “The results derived from Eq.(2) are”. The equation requires the indent, the consecutive number, and the blank lines

above and below.

$$m_1 \ddot{x}_1 = f_x \quad (1)$$

$$b = \frac{d(e+f)}{g+h} \quad (2)$$

where b is a ABC parameter [kN]. The fraction such as Eq.(2) is typed as $b=d(e+f)/(g+h)$ in main text.

Using SI units are strongly encouraged. The Roman types (not Greek symbols) are used for the units or symbols, for example, 6.01 kN, $1.01 \times 10^3 \Omega$, 25.3° and $1.6 \times 10^{-6} \mu\text{m}$. And the italic types are used for the quantities and variables, for example, $\mu = 2.01 \times 10^{-3}$ and $1.78k$.

7 Citations and references

List and number all references at the end of the paper. Type the corresponding number in square brackets as shown at the end of this sentence when you cite references in the text [#].

7.1 Journals

Write in the following order as in the following examples: Author's family name, initials (of given and middle names), title, journal title, volume, issue (year of publication), starting page. Author names should include family name and initials of all co-authors [1], [2].

7.2 Books

Write in the following order as in the following examples: Author's family name, initials (of given and middle names), book title, place of publication (year of publication), starting page. Author names should include family name and initials of all co-authors [3]-[5].

7.3 Online journal and others

In case of online journal or others referred online, access information, URL, DOI and accessed date, should be need to write in addition to journal information [6]-[8].

8 Manuscript and Electronic submission

The conference proceedings will be published through the electronic submissions of the authors. Thus manuscripts are to be made as PDF files and then sent to the program committee.

8.1 Manuscript

Note in particular that for PDF file, only **Times New Roman** font should be used, and embedded. DO NOT include multibyte characters to minimize the risk of printing errors. Please note that the manuscript file does not exceed 5Mbytes in order to avoid the trouble due to the capacity of the server.

8.2 Electronic submission

Manuscripts are submitted from ICDES2020 submission site, "<https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/5ICDES2020>", according to below;

- (1) Access the website "<https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/5ICDES2020>".
- (2) Create new account (fill into the submit author's information).
- (3) Log in from website using your account.
- (4) Select the conference "The 5th International Conference on Design Engineering and Science (ICDES2020 organized by JSDE)" from [all conferences].
- (5) When you submit your manuscript first time, click [Create new submission], then upload your manuscript file.

- (6) If you want to modify your manuscript, you can re-upload your revised manuscript file any time before paper submission deadline.

Manuscripts are submitted before the deadlines in **Table 2**. Authors must strictly keep the following deadlines.
